The temperature should be good the entire length of the wb and for the first 3-10 miles of the main (all depends on cfs released, air temp, amount of sunshine). Lordville gauge is 10 miles below the junction and until recently, it's stayed in the mid 60's. Any doubt, take the temperature.

You will find out that the water temp may help or hurt you. If it's too cold, the hatch never gets going or fog forms and shuts everything down. The lower you are on the river, the less likely you will get fogged out. Also monitor rainfall before heading up. One downpour and Ocagua is pumping straight yoohoo into the river.
