I don't want to pre-empt YRG, but will say that the river from the dam above Confluence down to Ohiopyle is probably still pretty cold. That is, in the comfort zone for trout. And, there are surprising hatches somewhat "out-of-season" for other waters you may be familiar with.

BWOs, flying ants. light mayflies of several varieties, caddis from dark to light, and the midges, Lord, the midges.

Try a search of stream reports for "Yough" and look for threads started in mid- to late- July. You will probably see a lot of bugs mentioned.
