The biggest thing that will help you eliminate drag is to approach the fish from the correct angle. Learning to check your cast will allow you to get some slack in the leader. Reach cast and other techniques will improve your chances.

Next time you spy one on top, try this.....before you cast or worry about what the fish is taking, look. Look at where the fish is holding. Look at the angle you have to approach him. Look at how many different currents exist between you and your target. Is your spot the best possible option? Can you move a little to give yourself a better angle? Can you move slightly and it eliminates some of the water flowing at different speeds? If you look before you leap, I'll bet you bring more to net.
