Where is the "spook point" of a trout? If you take just one step closer, will they spook, what about 2? They're calling this the "competition kit" for the specifics of competing and having the ability to change your rod to the conditions you're fishing. A longer rod can keep more line off the water for more tight line nymphing that many competitors use. A longer rod also helps to mend line better during the drift in either spanish or french nymphing and also in swinging streamers. Why do you think that the old glass rods are all significantly shorter than the modern graphite rods? They're adhering to the more modern styles of fly fishing and making a rod to match.
