I thought the Trout LT reminded me of a triangle taper when I was reading about it. My shop tried to push me toward the Wulff Triangle Taper but I didn't think it would quite fit my needs to a "T". I don't do a whole lot of roll casting unless necessary. Also the majority of my flies are size 12-16.

After reading your explanations I'm happy with my line decision in theory, I hope that plays out once it's on the rod. I know the price ain't that friendly, but I've been searching for one of these rods for awhile so I wanted the right line for it. In reality it was only \$15 more than the Rio Gold.

I'd have no problem meeting up to cast the lines side by side, but based on your location listed, we are a good distance away. I live in south central PA.
