There are quite a few options in southeast PA ("SEPA") in Sept. Much depends on how much time you have and how far you're willing to drive. If you're willing to drive at least 2 hours, there are countless trout fishing opportunities north or west of the Philly area. Two hours will also put you on the beach at the Jersey shore. The counties surrounding Philly are Chester, Bucks, and Montgomery. If you check the Stream Reports forum you can see reports from specific waters in those areas. Most of the waters in these counties are within about an hour drive depending on where you're staying. Many of the stocked trout streams in SEPA will have few, if any, trout left as most streams in PA get too warm to hold trout over the summer. There are streams with wild trout in these counties but many more if you're willing to drive further.

If it were me, I'd drive up the Delaware River and fish for smallmouth bass.
