### Male Trico Spinner

**Hook:** Size 2, 4X long streamer hook

**Thread:** GSP 200 denier black

**Tail:** Pine squirrel zonker strip

**Body:** Brown deer hair from the back of a bucktail

**Underbelly:** 4 millimeter tan foam

**Head:** 4 millimeter tan foam, folded over hook eye

- 1 Tie in tails at the bend of the hook. Tie in the dark brown tails, so they are longer than normal (longer than the length of the shank of the hook) and split.
- 2 Dub in fine dark brownish black poly for the body.
- 3 Wind dubbed poly up to a point just behind the eye and tie off.
- 4 Tie in a small (about the size of a matchstick) white poly yarn or Z-lon. Secure wings by making a couple figure 8's.
