I use to live in Abingdon and could be at the dam in 20 min...there are always fish to catch, spring the shad run is a must, in June & July I have had great luck catching white perch on small clousers, smallies are there april through november. Come late September the stripers are great! Everyone will be up throwing stuff into the discharge looking for 2 keepers while there are schools of 10-16 inch fish from the fishing platform down, I get there at least once or twice each year late sept and catch close to 100 fish on clousers size 6-1/0 its a blast!!!

Hit me up if you ever want some company. I am new to that part of the river. I go on a guide trip every spring in the flats for stripers.
