It's difficult to prevent sometimes. I notice it more with streamers than poppers, but still. Try moving to a heavier tippet...say 10 or 12 lb mono...the cheap stuff you'd put on a spinning reel. That's pretty thick stuff and it should be harder for the fly to twist it as you cast and strip. You can also try just changing flies. Sometimes one will be less prone to line twist due to minor differences, even in a seemingly identical pattern. Other than that, just deal with it and replace your tippet section every hour or so...easy to do with a braided leader and cheap if you're buying regular old mono in the big spools.
