I never mentioned ethics, but rather protecting the fish. You and I differ about the probability of a fish scraping its slime off or knocking a scale free swimming in the water as opposed to being laid on land with its weight on a number of uneven rocks, but you clearly take some care to insure that fish live after photos.
