Turkey, to answer your question. My Richardson is also a 4 tray model but with the deluxe green finish. The finish on it is very durable and looks great. I thought about getting a 5 tray but went with the 4 . I have no regrets. I really like it. I have had mine about 4 or 5 years. I use the front tray as a work station. I keep shot, tippet rings, knot tool, forceps and sometimes tippet material in the first tray. Tray 2 and 3 I use for wets, some streamers and nymphs. The 4th tray is used for dry flies as the compartments are deeper than on tray 2 or 3. Overall my Richardson was one of the best purchases I made for flyfishing with the possible exception of my 4 and 5 weight Sage SLT flyrods
