I've never had a problem. I put them back in my Richardson from whence they came, and do nothing special. The Richardson is FAR from watertight, which makes it far from airtight too, I think allowing them to dry without wetting other flies. I've even gone down and dunked the thing before, didn't even leave it open overnight. Dry by morning.

Exception: Saltwater. If I fish saltwater, the Richardson and my trout flies do not see the light of day. I fill a small fly box for saltwater use. At the end of each day, the entire box gets hosed, including flies that weren't even used.
