I'll second LLBean's waders- any kind. So far they haven't been as rugged as I'd hoped (heck.. the Kennebec waders I currently have are on their THIRD PAIR THIS YEAR), but the small issues I had were still enough for me to return the pair for a shiny new one (when I'm paying over 200 for a pair I want them to work down to the laces). These new waders cost me about 50 bucks because I sent in my old leaky pair for the \$190 credit.

So- build issues can be a problem, but with a lifetime warranty (actually a satisfaction guarantee instead), you can always upgrade for a few bucks. At worst I've paid 7 bucks shipping to turn in a year old pair.

Don't let me scare you- buy LLBean for waders. You will *always* wear your waders out. That's a given. This way you never lose that initial equity.
