Respectfully, it's possible you and TB may have done well as a result of (rather than in spite of) the recent rains. The stream looks as though it's falling and clearing after the rain, which are classic trout fishing conditions, and exactly when I prefer to fish, especially after the low-flows of summer.

That's why we went there.

RLeeP told me about "storm chasing" on the freestone streams a long time ago. Thanks Bob!

Look at the USGS gauges, see where the water is way up from recent rains, and go.

It's some of the most enjoyable fishing there is. Not just because you often catch a lot of fish. But also because it is just great being out there when the streams are roaring.
