Yellow creek is a bit out of the way, but one of my favorite streams.

You can fish the Frankstown branch of the Juniata which runs through claysburg. That would only be about 10 minutes away. It gets a lot of pressure but it is do able.

Bobs creek is out past claysburg on rout 869, i have yet to fish this in the late season though.

The little J is probably your best bet. Great stream, and tough to fish certain sections.

If you want to venture up rout 22 there are a few streams up here as well. If you want to fish a Class-A wild trout water there is Benscreek outside of Portage, the lower end is stocked. The Little Conemaugh is also stocked from Cresson to Portage. I can give you a few spots on these to try as well. They are about 2 minutes from my house. These would be about 15-20 minutes away from Altoona. They are small streams, but hold fish year round.
