One of the benefits of fishing late-summer, low water conditions, though, is that I finally get to see what the stream structure is. When its up and off-color in the spring, I sometimes had no idea if I was fishing in six inches or six feet of water.

And thats a general plug for getting out at times with the intent not necessarily to fish, but to explore and learn the stream.
