I agree with Pcray, McSneek, and Chaz. Your problem is probably one or more of those things. If I had to put money on it, I'd say you're pulling the fly out of the fish's mouth using the bass master hook set and either striking too soon or too late. You may have the dull hook problem compounding your frustration. Watch the fish eat, set to the side and downstream. If you're making contact and not connecting check the hook point. After all is said, sometimes the fish just wins the fight. If you caught every fish that ate your fly it would be called catching, not fishing. That's the sport of it.
