It's tough to say without seeing them, but I typically only use the parts of hackle that are all the same width. If you're doing this, then you're on the right track. The quality of hackle is extremely important, thus I do have some recommendations for you in the future.

You may consider purchasing saddle hackles versus capes, though they have both up- and downsides. Saddles are great bc of their length (which can be upwards of 8" - 10"), though @ times, you sacrifice by having a narrowed size selection (for hook/fly size).

My advice is to always buy the best hackle you're able to afford; two places I recommend are:

Clearwater Hackle

Collins Hackle

These are both run by great guys that you can call and talk to. Simply letting them know the most common flies you tie can then get you the hackle you need.
