Well, right on schedule.....they opened the gates yet again. I don't care if I plan this for early September or mid October, they've hit me with a big release 3 out of 4 years. It's right around 1100 cfs release. Wading the wb at that flow is not advised / dangerous except for those with lots of hours on that river. That's the bad news. The good news is that it won't impact floaters too much. 90% of fishing will be done from the boat. The main should be fine to wade. The east, upper east and Beaverkill are all low and very wadeable.

Side note- flow can go from the current 1100 cfs to 150 cfs in a matter of 3 hrs. You never know until you're there so come on up and we'll adjust the plan of attack if we need to.
