The yough fishes well all year round, but I'd check the usgs gauge before heading there to make sure it's not too high if we happen to get rain. I'm sure you'll see a good bit of insect activity but the most abundant is the caddis in sizes 14-22 sometimes smaller, as well as October Caddis in the evenings. I always carry small rusty spinners (blue Quill), and Bwo olive patterns as well for they could hatch at anytime during the day on the yough. I have heard reports from laurel highland guide services that the streamer bite has been slow, but you never know being that fall is here.
