Please choose a pattern that fits into one of the following categories, and list it in your signup post. Duplicates are OK, but try to pick a pattern that hasn't already been chosen.

#### **Categories:**

- Catskill style dries
- parachute style dries
- comparadun and hairwing style dries
- emergers
- immitative nymphs
- attractor nymphs
- terrestrials
- wet flies
- streamers
- "other" flies

#### **Things to bring:**

All Tools and materials to tie your chosen demo fly. A tying lamp and any extension cords you need - there's an ample number of outlets on the walls behind the tying tables.

Bring any food or drinks you'd like to, but save room for dinner! We'll provide spring water on ice.

We encourage beginner tyers to attend, and we'll have beginner instruction set up at a table run by Hokendauqua TU.
