Glad you caught some fish! I'll tell you what though, the pools between those riffles can have some good dry fly fishing.

Suggestion would be the area above and downstream of where the Pohopoco dumps into the Lehigh. There is parking across the street from River Walks. From there you can get down to the river and cross over.

Of course this depends on how aggressive of a wader you are, but anything less than 600cfs on the Lehighton gage is manageable with cleats and staff.

Unfortunately this weekend is a whitewater release. Below is what the Corps is forecasting to dump. Fortunately though this is the last one of the year. Finally!
