I carry a round 6" metal canister, about 1 1/2" thick. I use tweezers to pick them out. After each trip, they are washed in clean water and hung to dry on tree-stand I made. I try to bring along sizes and types that I need for the session and store my collection in plano boxes at home. People may think it my method seems like a p.i.t.a. but it works for me and my flies last as long as I want them too.

The wife got the canister at somewhere like Potterybarn or something like that about 10 years ago. I found in the basement about 5 years ago and stopped dealing with the fake wool/foam stuff about then. I got the idea from what Lee Wulff used to carry that I read in a magazine.
