Benn catching those in Clark's fly area for 20 years. Fish shallow, crappy water where bigger fish won't live and they are in there. A perfect example is walk in by the white barn, cross the riff above the bend (to your right). Fish below that pool in the ankle deep riff with a caddis. You'll catch a few tiny brookies (3-4").

Back in the 1988-89, I'd trico fish the quittie before it got back on the stocking list. Took some beautiful Brown's and bows in the meadows. Some of fish were 16-18" too. There's fish in more places than you'd think.

Gros,

At one time, I think eggs were bought from fish on the beaverhead or other Montana river. You can only breed / cross breed so many times before you get Brown's with no colored spots and the black dots turn into worm patterns
