I've has 2. It's a pretty fast yet smooth rod. I really liked it. Both broke though so they were returned. Actually every Cabelas rod I've owned has broken during casting, fighting a fish and believe it or not....stringing up the rod. Never suffered that type of failure with a Sage, St Croix or Redington.

Maybe the new ones are improved but the old ones (4 yrs ago) had very thin walls on the blanks. If you don't mind the inconvenience of broken sticks, it does perform very well.
