For me , on one of my usual beats , fallfish fill in a niche where it gets too warm for trout (they are usually piled up around spring holes and small cold tribbs , they are stressed out and not easy to catch when they are in this mode and i also think catching them at this time is quite often killing them.....negative trout time) but the fallfish move right into the niche , they take up many of the lies where the trout were only a short time ago , they feed readily on top and they fight quite well not to mention they get pretty big and fight well. It seems to happen seamlessly and when it cools down again the reverse seems to happen smoothly too. Biggest fallfish i ever caught was close to 24" , i measured a spot on the rod and then measured that later.....some wiggle room. There is no doubt in my mind that could have been the same fish , while trout are pretty vulnerable when it's like that fallfish are TOUGH and i think more likely to survive. COOL POST!!!! Fallfish Unlimited=F.U. ....heh
