My colleagues have told me that it is no longer what it was for large trout when I used to fish it religiously for big browns (1976-1979). I lived a mile from the stream at the time and fished it about every other evening during the summer when I was not working away from the area. Nevertheless, at that time, we once electrofished a single pass for 1.5 miles and handled 270 brown trout fourteen inches long and longer. Twenty-seven were 20 inches long and longer. The longest was 27 inches. At the time it was the probably the best stream in the state for large browns. It was a very heavily pressured stream, but the large browns were not impacted by the pressure brought on by stocking over these fish. They were only occasionally caught by those anglers attracted to the stockings. Most of the big browns were caught after the stocking crowd had left most of the stockies had been harvested.
