Flyfish1998, Check the fly tying forum for the rubber legs thread. Dc410, The Holsclag Hackle fly is a first rate bass fly, I tie mine to large for a good mega chub fly. If you want to go that route, I suggest putting rubber legs on a Clouser Darter. If I was more energetic I would post some pictures of the pattern. I like brown or olive. I have also had good luck with chartreuse. Whatever for the body Diamond braid is kind of cool. Pair of rubber legs behind dumbbells and calf tail wing w/ a little flash. You get the picture. Deadly. Smaller, slimmer profile than the Hackle fly. Better Low clear water fly for bass than the Hackle fly. Slower drop on the hop.

Beauty is in the eye of the beholder. Silver trout they are man. With that said it's fun to go ugly. In college we would have called it going Chubbing.

Interesting side note. I was fishing for fallfish when I caught my first trout on a dry fly of my own design. I was 12. We haven't discussed it here yet but, Fallfish are excellent surface feeders and however you catch them they do take some skill to catch.
