This is the "hatch and entomology" forum. We are identifying bugs, not fly patterns. I could do without the latin, but right now, that's the only naming method which is actually based on biological classification.

Often a fly pattern is named after the common name for a bug, or vice versa. But the two should not be confused. You can use a March Brown fly to match a Hendrickson hatch with success. That does not mean that the bug is a March Brown.
