Thanks. Thinking about wild trout coloration and trying to paint them never gets boring, at least for me. The fish in the middle and upper pics you posted show the dark belly and nearly black fins so typical on Great Lakes tribbs fish but that shows up from time to time on stream fish. Notice also, on the upper pic of the fish in the water....that the back and shoulders are green rather than brown as well as including the faint reddish brown spots I was alluding to.
