Had 5 repairs done by sage. When I called about the last repair, I asked if they would put a new handle and wraps on my three weight that I got in 1984. "no" was their reply. I said that the butt section is so faded it doesn't even look like the same rod and maybe I can get the bottom replaced if it breaks. Maybe the lady gave me a BS story but she said it was \$50 to repair / replace a tip or mid section but it was a different cost for a butt section.

At any rate, his has broken more than once I imagine they will try to make things right and not charge more than \$50. With that said, 3 repair fees plus shipping costs the same as a new rod in many cases.
