My season ends when the opener begins pretty much. I am a nut and go out when it is ridiculously cold. As long as the water is open, I will go out.

I found last year I have just as much sucesss on larger nymphs 10-6 as I do the small stuff. Many trout last year were caught on size 8 stonefly patterns of squirrel and rabbit dubbing. The fights are not as intense, and I try to get them to the net as quick as I can. Coldest temps I went out in were 15 degrees with a real feel of -2. Gotta love it. I don't even deer hunt in those kinds of temperatures, but ill go out and stand in a creek. LOL go figure.
