Egg patterns are absolutely killer in the winter time. Even long after the spawn is complete, the fish seem to remember them for months. In addition to the egg patterns, I will often drop a small unweighted nymph off of the back of the egg. Many fish will be attracted to the egg, reject it, and take the smaller nymph. The only difference in the way I fish it from what you described is I fish the eggs unweighted with a small split shot 5 or 6 inches from the egg. I use many weighted flies with great luck. Eggs for me just seem to be better unweighted with splitshot.
