When we are not Steelheading , we swing wolly buggers and streamers . The fish that are hungry will bite, the others use to a 32 no-seeum whadsworth butterfly nymph can go hungry. We usualy catch less, but bigger fish in the winter. Afternoons are the best time and Sunny days are better. You can cover more water in less time this way, it's an adaptation of Salmon/Steelheading techniques that catches fish in a shorter period of time.
