After my Korkers finally crapped out on me, i picked up a pair of Simms boots on sale at Cabelas with a Vibram sole. I had the same worry about wading. I've used felt bottoms for as long as I can remember and this was a big switch for me. The Simms studs were crazy expensive for them, so I studded them with 1/2 inch Kold Cutter racing studs. I actually think the studs are way better than my felt ever was. I don't think I'd go back now. If you do any winter fishing in the snow, they perform 10x better than felt. No more ice buildup on the soles. If you buy a pair that are unstudded, I'd recommend the Kold Cutter studs for them. You can pick up a 200 pack on eBay for about \$20. That's enough to stud your boots for a lifetime.
