No such animal exists from Fenwick. There were other vendors, but they're going to be exceedingly rare. If you need a true 4wt rod, you're going to need to buy a blank and have it built. Modern vendors produce 4wt, and lighter, fiberglass rods.

If your goal is to actually swing wet flies, you won't do any better than a South Fork "Classic." If you want a 7'6" rod 4wt, they happen to have one. The blank will set you back \$128, the finished rod \$289.

Since you're looking for shorter, there's plenty of vintage 6wt rated rods in the 7'6" to 8' range out there. YMMV as to which one.
