I am in the beginning phases of starting to plan some trips up to Valley Creek.

I don't personally recommend this particular stream as a good fit for beginners. However, now that you're ready to give it a try, I'd suggest some points. Valley is a smaller stream that is more heavily fished than most PA limestoneers. The first thing you want to be aware of is courtesy toward other anglers. Don't walk upstream from another angler and start fishing (if you're not sure about courtesy, politely ask other anglers if they mind where you are moving into the stream). Stay out of the water and when you do wade, move as slowly and quietly as you can. In addition to courtesy and stealth, the points listed further up this thread are good ones.
