My opinion is that a mouse fly that looks like a mouse is just as likely to catch a fisherman as a fish, meaning I don't think the trout inspect a mouse fly to see if it has eyes, etc. I like the Blair Mouse because it can push water well (it incorporates aspects of the Gurgler) and the rubber legs/tail have a good swimming motion.
