The canyon is 18 miles long between Ansonia and Blackwell - with one other access place at the midpoint called Tiadaughton, at which there is a campground.

The whole canyon can certainly be floated in 1 day, but a 2 day float would be more enjoyable, and leave a lot more time for fishing.

Besides overnighting at Tiadaughton, you can also camp primitively at many other points through the canyon with a permit from the DCNR.

I would recommend doing it in the spring time, when the water is up. Stream levels usually get very low during the summer and fall.

Fishing for trout is also best in the spring. It is well stocked by the state, and there are some tremendous hatches coming off then too.
