Dryflyguy has it right. That would be my advice as well. I will add this however; if you wish to float below the canyon area in the summer months you can stay at Pettecote Junction campground in Cedar Run and float downriver from there or use that as your takeout point. There are a few access points in Slate Run that make for a good day trip. That section will be all smallmouth fishing in the summer with maybe an occasional trout or two near the mouths of Cedar or Slate. You also have the option to fish those streams and a few brookie streams in the area too. I have kayaked that section in the late summer months and as long as the water is not too low you will be fine. It is an easy float.
