The haystack is a dry fly, tied on a standard dry fly hook, has a tail, does not have a well defined thorax or hackle, and Betters used woodchuck. But it does have some orange thread showing, so I understand the confusion.

It's a nice pattern, and call it what you want. I agree the foam won't do much for you. It looks like it will present a nice profile but won't float for long. You could try a bit of snowshoe in the thorax or the wing. That will make the Betters fans happy.
