Depends on where, and when, I'm fishing.

Generally, elk hair works for me almost everywhere. However, in heavily fished streams (Spring Creek) and/or sections , I firmly believe fish tend to recognize the elk hair silhouette as something to avoid, especially as the season progresses. And though I can usually get some takes it seems like I often have to work harder.

So I also carry the Henryville Special and CDC patterns to use in those situations. I remember several times on Spring Creek, when green caddis were everywhere and my EHC was getting a lukewarm reception, I would switch to a Henryville and the fish would become noticeably more aggressive on the takes.
