In general, larger streams warm up. There are plenty of smallish, high gradient, forested, freestone streams in the region that really don't get that much above 60, and are plenty cold year round.

Limestoneers and tailwaters can throw a curve ball to the general rules, and allow cold temperatures on larger streams, or in streams that aren't as shaded. You don't have much in the way of limestoneers in that region. As far as tailwaters, each one is very different, so you just have to learn the trends of that particular waterway.
