Wetnet, for my soft-hackle wets, I usually use them only during caddis hatches, but here's my basic tie.

Use the drop-down menu and pick "tan soft-hackle".

Call that hackle, a wing, whatever you want. I think of it as a wing but tied in the round. It's an incredibly easy tie that even I can do, and it works both deaddrifted or swung, so that's good enough for me. Of course, change the body color and size to the caddis you wish to match.
