I think it's about as tough as a stream as they come. That includes Valley and Letort and ranks right up there with them.

We established that, but not for the reasons of the other two you mentioned. The fish are pellet fed everyday. They are eating dog food consistently NOT NATURAL FORAGE. Therefore it's not an accurate assesment to put them on the same ballfield as the Letort or Valley. So when they refuse your fly it's not b/c of your fly or you.....Their looking for PURINA DOG CHOW. As mentioned before, a lot of fish come out of nowhere when those pellets start floating down. Fish you would normally not see....they do the same thing at LLH in the area they call the kiddie pool. I don't think you can compare Lititz to the other two mentioned. The fish may be really big there. But it's b/c they're being fed dog food, not natural forage. So your comparison is not really a comparison at all.

Don't put spin on this. I didn't say it wasn't hard. But the level of difficulty is due to being fed dog food.

Therefore, you really can't put the three in the same park. You can put the Letort and Valley in the same park but not Lititz.
