A technouque called the leisenring lift seems to work the best for me and put at least one small shot right above the fly on the tippet no more than say 3" cast upstream of where you think the fish is to let it gain depth and when you get to where you think the fish is lift and even strip a little sometimes and then again sometimes all you really have to do is lift an over zealous mend while lifting the rod tip i think is a good way to describe it
