It may be premature to claim that the fingerlings were superior to the adult stockings. I would like to suggest that anglers spend this spring fishing the Tully; keep track of how many adults they catch from last year's adult stockings; and note their color, size, abundance, and fighting ability. Then formulate an opinion. (The irregular pattern of fin regrowth will likely be a fairly reliable giveaway in many cases as to whether or not the fish originated as an adult or fingerling based upon my catches this past winter. This should be fairly clear to you if you have caught many of the adults that originated as fingerlings in the past). Additionally, you may still catch some small browns, as fingerling browns were stocked in Sept., the result of an unusual availability of these fish in the hatchery system in the late summer of '06.
