I use the bat test; if a bat picks up my fly I figure it's good enough for trout.

Until trout start "seeing" with radar (sonar?) I don't think that test holds water! 

I would think that a few layers of light colored thread usually covers up the hook enough, especially on the larger and bulkier flies. But it's easy enough to tell by soaking the fly and checking whether it's the right color. I never really noticed it before, but I haven't been looking for it.
