My suggestion would be to look at the hackle. An easy fix is to trim about a 1/16th of an inch off on the bottom of the fly; or at least any long fibers. I use whiting 100's and occasionally get a long fiber that throws every thing off. After trimming set it on your desk and like previously said the hook bend should just be off the table. If the fly still tips, the wings are probably too long.
